**SUMMARY:** The facilities/food unit leader (depending upon the magnitude of the response organization, this job can be split into two positions) is responsible for the layout and activation of incident facilities (e.g., Base, CAMP(s), and ICP). The Facilities Unit Leader provides sleeping and sanitation facilities for incident personnel and manages Base and Camp(s) operations. The Food Unit Leader is responsible for supplying the food needs for the entire incident, including all remote locations (e.g., Camps, Staging Areas), and also including food for personnel unable to leave tactical field assignments.
